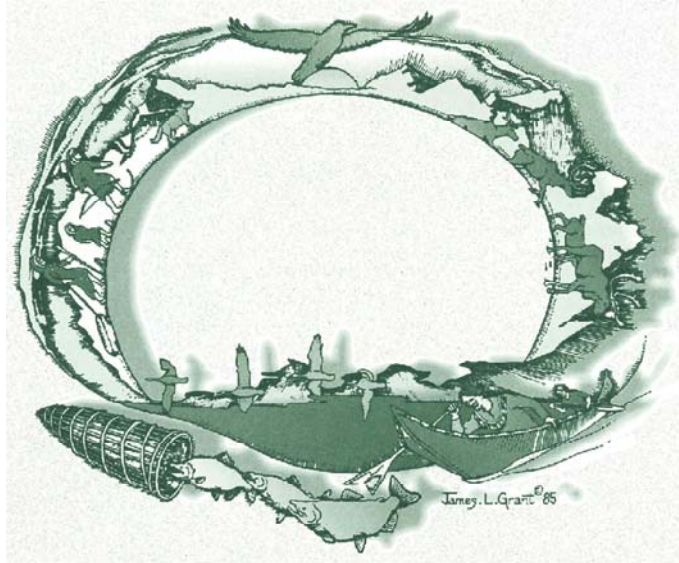

# **FISCAL YEAR 2007 INDIAN FORESTRY STATUS REPORT TO CONGRESS**

## **INTRODUCTION**

### **Public Law 101-630, National Indian Forest Resources Management Act of 1990**

25 U.S.C. 3111 (c) STATUS REPORT TO CONGRESS.-The Secretary shall submit, within 1 year of the first full fiscal year after November 28, 1990 and within 6 months of the end of each succeeding fiscal year, a report to the Committee on Natural Resources of the United States House of Representatives, the Committee on Indian Affairs of the United States Senate, and to the affected Indian tribes a report on the status of Indian forest lands with respect to standards, goals and objectives set forth in approved forest management plans for each Indian tribe with Indian forest lands. The report shall identify the amount of Indian forest land in need of forestation or other silviculture treatment and the quantity of timber available for sale, offered for sale, and sold for each Indian tribe.
